Notes (If you would like to add/explain anything):	This collection of tenure categories is documented by experiences of dwellers: *1) Since the winter is very cold, the unauthorized dwellers of housing, which is attributed for demolishion, have the rhight of non-eviction during this weather *2) housing which has not been used by any owner, someone can legalize the plot after 3 years of use *3) A dacha (russion country house) can be rented. If the government needs the plot for further developement, it has the right for eviction *4) Someone living with elderly, for this assistance the inherit can be transferred to the dweller *5) commonly a dacha is attributed to have a temporary residential permission and a resticted permanent construction. After some time there is the possibility to upgrade the construction permission for building sufficent housing *6) After the Sowjet Union land was given to people for free, when it used to be e.g agricultural use. The ownership contains the same rights, like the Free-holder
